Interconnection Check List

- 1. Familiarize yourself with the interconnect application and agreement. This describes the interconnection process.
- 2. Once you have decided to proceed with an interconnection, complete and return the following documents to **bsloan@orbgdpu.com**
 - Application to Interconnection Small Generator 20 kW or Less for residential or 50 kW or less for non-residential
 - Interconnection Agreement
 - Homeowner's proof of minimum Liability Insurance coverage
 - Electrical Design Plan (interconnection requirements, size and operation plan). As part of the interconnection analysis performed by DPU, the applicant will be provided with an estimate of any line extension or other cost to be incurred in providing electric delivery service to the applicant's facility if determined necessary.
- 3. Upon notification of Interconnection Application from DPU, please submit application fee (\$100) payment to **Tara Rivers** by calling 803-268-4181.
- 4. After construction of the Interconnected Generation system is complete, and after you have received the final electrical inspection from the local building codes authority, please contact DPU for an interconnection approval inspection. Please do not close, or allow your electrician / installer to close, (place in the "on" position) the lockable disconnect switch until DPU has conducted its safety inspection of the installation.
- 5. After the interconnection has passed DPU's inspection and all requirements have been satisfied, DPU will email "permission to operate"
